**Directions to Edibles:**

Do not follow Sat Nav to HD7 5XA as you'll end up on a mule track high up on the hill!  
Paddock Farm is situated between Marsden and Slaithwaite, not far from the A62.

**By train:**

Marsden is the nearest station which has an hourly connection to Huddersfield and then from the Transpennine rail service, and also a direct service to Manchester Victoria station. It is a very pleasant one mile walk or cycle down the tow path to Paddock Farm - please get in touch ([rosie@edibles.org.uk](mailto:rosie@edibles.org.uk)) if you require directions from the tow path.

**By car, coming from Sheffield or the West:** Turning off the A62 into Marsden village centre is probably easiest. If coming from the West on the M62, come off at Junction 21 (no exit at Junction 22) and come through Newhey, Denshaw and Delph, then over the Pennines on the A62.

Once in Marsden, the main High Street that you turn into (signed Marden Mechanics, railway station) is called Peel Street, with shops either side and Marsden Mechanics Hall on your Right, and the Coop on your left. At the end of the shops the road swings to the left (by the Swan pub) - don't swing left, but turn Right on this corner up Warehouse Hill (derelict mill sheds on your right). After 3/4 mile (you pass out of Marsden, down a hill, up through woods and out onto a flat straight bit), as you leave the woods, Park Gate cottages are on your left. Paddock Farm is about 200m on the Right. You will see the gable end of The Barn facing you, and our timber side extension by the road. Look out for the yellow flag. You will be fine parking there on the road, but try to park by the fields rather than alongside our neighbour's house. If you pass under the railway, you've gone 400m too far. See also this map (just ignore that they show us on Marsden Lane. DO NOT use Sat Nav).

**By car, coming from Slaithwaite and the East:** If you are coming on the M62, please note that you cannot leave the M62 at Junction 23 coming from the East. You need to come off at junction 24 and take the A643 to Junction 24, then go through Outlane, turn down into Slaithwaite and out the other side onto the A62.

Leave Slaithwaite on the A62, heading West towards Marsden/Manchester/Oldham. After a mile or so there's a run down garage on the left (West End Garage). Turn Right here (opposite the garage) down West Slaithwaite Rd, which takes you down over the canal, and keep on this road which becomes Crow Trees Rd, then Kettle Lane and eventually (though unmarked) Park Gate Road. You will pass under the railway, up the hill past a terrace of houses on the right, head down the other side, under the railway again, turn right after this second railway bridge and Paddock Farm is the third house on your left (large wooden front extension and attached to farmhouse) - look out for the yellow flag.

Look out for the yellow flag. You will be fine parking there on the road, but try to park by the fields rather than alongside our neighbour's house. If you pass under the railway, you've gone 400m too far. See also this map (just ignore that they show us on Marsden Lane. DO NOT use Sat Nav).

This map should make it clearer. N.B. this map calls Park Gate Road, Marsden Lane.
